COURSE INFORMATION

IAS offers 2 bridging programmes suitable for students from various backgrounds. If you have a SAICA accredited undergraduate degree (Chartered Accountant stream) but obtained this a while ago and therefore need a refresher before you enter the PGDA, the BCTA 2 programme is for you. It is a 5.5 month programme and on successful completion you can join the PGDA. If you do not have a SAICA accredited undergraduate degree the 11 month programme is for you. You will start with the BCTA 1 programme (5.5 months), and on successful completion join the BCTA 2 programme. Both programmes offer extensive coverage in Management Accounting and Finance, Financial Accounting, Auditing and Taxation and will provide you with a solid foundation before entering the PGDA. We also offer both programmes in a January and a June intake, you can therefore start your studies when convenient for you.

BCTA 1: This course offers an introduction to the base concepts of Management Accounting and Finance, Financial Accounting, Auditing and Taxation. It solidifies your foundation in each discipline to prepare you for BCTA 2.

BCTA 2: This course offers extensive coverage of the foundational content of Management Accounting and Finance, Financial Accounting, Auditing and Taxation as well as prepares students for the integrative nature of the discipline content.

The IAS BCTA programme is accredited by SAICA for the AGA route. The programme is not accredited with the DHET. The IAS DHET accreditation is attached to the PGDA, therefore once you complete the bridging and PGDA, you will have accreditation from the DHET.
